<p>Apply for exchange student program</p>	<p>[Step 1]</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Online application ▪ https://m.buufs.ac.kr/nonDegree_Default.aspx <p>※For details on how to apply online, refer to the 'Mobility Program Application Guide].</p> <p>[Step 2]</p> <p>Upon receiving [Step 1] documents, we will apply for <u>“Certificate of Admissions” otherwise referred to as : “<Form-CA></u> from the Immigration Office of Korea, Ministry of Justice.</p> <p>[Step 3]</p> <p>After approved by the Korean Immigration, we will “send” the hard copy of the <u><“Form-CA”> via</u> international courier to the student’s home institution, along with other documents. Note: We don’t deliver them to the student individually.</p> <p>[Step 4]</p> <p>Upon receiving the <u>“Form-CA”</u> documents, the student shall apply for Student Visa at the nearest Korean Embassy/Consulate Office at student’s home country.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Important: Student are <u>required to apply for his/her visa at his/her HOME COUNTRY and Do not enter Korea BEFORE obtaining Student Visa(D-2).</u> ▪ Applying for the visa with “Form-CA” within Korean is NOT allowed by the Immigration Law of Korea, effective January 2019, albeit he or she is from partnership university. ▪ Due to a change in visa issuance procedure, in some cases, the Korean Embassy/Consulate might require a bank balance statement. For student staying for one semester at least 5,000 US dollars, and for one year at least 10,000 US dollars in bank balance.

<p>Insurance</p>	<p>Effective March 1st, 2021, and thereafter, All international students entering Korea with D-2 visas are REQUIRED by law to purchase Korean National Health Insurance during his/her entire study period and the cost of which is approx. 56,000 won (= \$50) per month.(This cost is not a fixed.)</p>

**Brief introduction of the
institute**

▪ **Division of International Studies(DIS)**

There are three tracks in the Division of International Studies: Business, Korean Language and Culture Education. The program characteristics of each track are explained briefly below.

▪ **Global Business Administration Track(GBA)**

Business track offers courses related to business administration and international trade, and its current official name is international trade management. The program aims to understand the activities of modern firms. The courses offered in this program are taught in English. The class consists of Korean Students as well as international students from many different countries. If a foreign student is admitted to the division of international studies, he/she may choose this track as a major or a minor. As for a domestic student, he/she is supposed to have an undeclared and exploratory major, and the student may choose this track later on, as a part of his/her academic program.

▪ **Korean Language and Culture Education Track**

This track provides educational services so that foreign students can develop their understanding of Korean language and Korean culture at an advanced level. In particular, it offers courses related to Korean language, Korean culture, and Korean interpretation and translation. The goal is to produce competent graduates who can be recognized as experts in the field of Korean language education, interpretation and translation. Only foreign students may choose this track as a major or a minor, though some of the courses, such as tandem, are open to domestic students. The classes are taught in Korean.
