Applicants (Students)

Joining this program will be an excellent opportunity to learn more about Korea and communicate with international students through a Korean language class, special lectures, and cultural exchanges with participants from other nations.

- You must be nominated by your home university to receive an email from KNU about an online interview in early December. After a brief interview at ZOOM, only students confirmed to participate in the program will receive a second guide email for the next step.

- Please double-check the personal information you provide to your home university (i.e., the spelling of your name in English, date of birth, email, etc.) and ensure there are no typos since that information will appear on a transcript.
- The Korean language class is for beginners who hardly know Korean, so unfortunately, if you are majoring in Korean over three years or are at a pre-intermediate level or above, this program will not be suitable for you.
- Please check that personal schedules, school classes, and exams do not conflict with the two-week program.
- ♠ You can share about yourself and communicate with other students by joining the following optional events. More information will be provided again in mid-December.

- · Culture Day (15-minute presentation about your country through PowerPoint)
- ♠ A transcript will be issued only when you have attended at least 80% of all classes, and KNU will officially send it to your home university, not to each student individually. You will not be eligible for a transcript if you are absent more than three days out of 10. There are no exams; the result will be pass or fail, not a grade.
