	National Health Insurance is mandated by the law.
	National Health Insurance is applied upon the issuance of the Residence Card.
	Details about registration and fees are TBA.
	Fees must be paied on a monthly basis.
Health Insurance	Private Health Insurance • As required by the Korean Ministry of Education, you are required to be covered by Korean private health insurance.
	For a one-time payment of approximately 85,000 KRW, you will be covered for one semester.
	The purpose of this private insurance is to prevent medical blind spots that occur from the moment you enter the country up until you are covered by the National Health Insurance, which takes a few months.
	Dormitory accommodation is provided to exchange students. Depending on the type of housing, rooms will be shared by 2 or 3 students. The assigned rooms may change due to circumstances.
	Location: All dormitories are located near the campus within 5 to 10 minutes walking distance from campus.
	• Room Assignment: The housing manager will assign the rooms in random according to the number of students.
	Applying for the dormitory: Check on 'Yes' to save your spot in our dormitory on your online application form.
