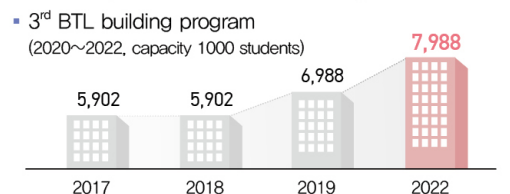

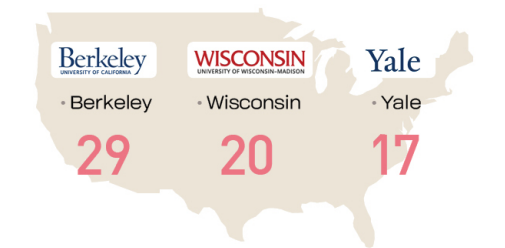


Healthy and safe campus life

Exchange Student Program at prestigious Universities

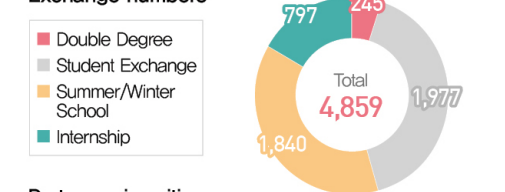

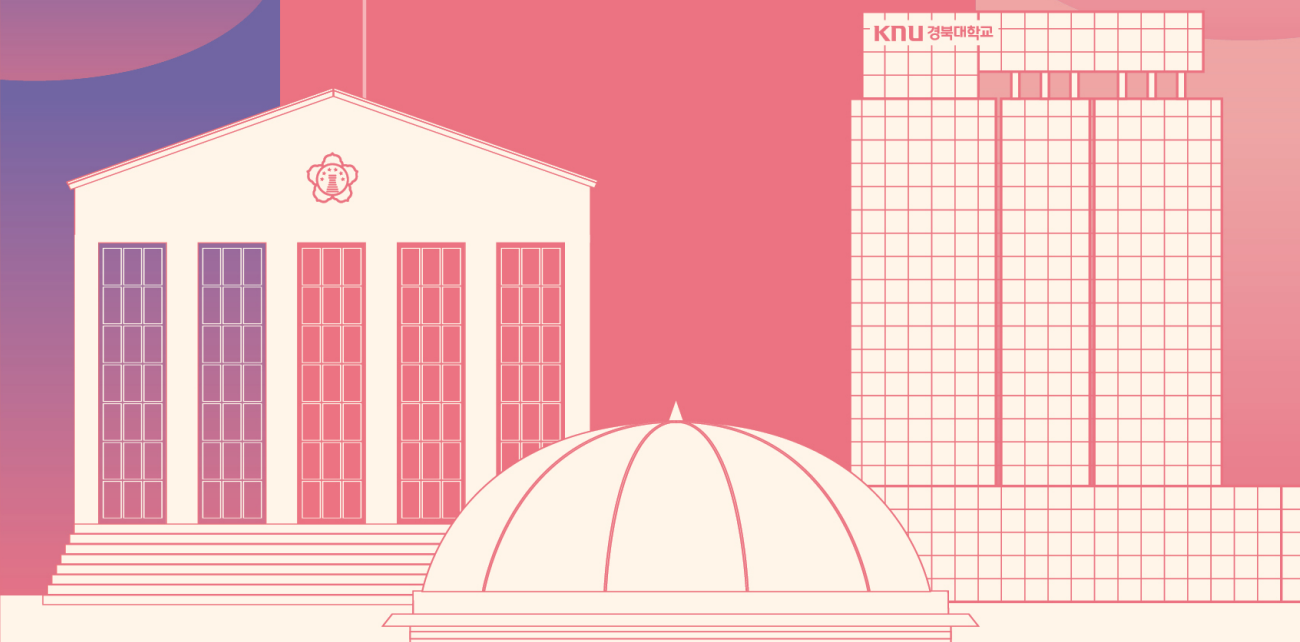

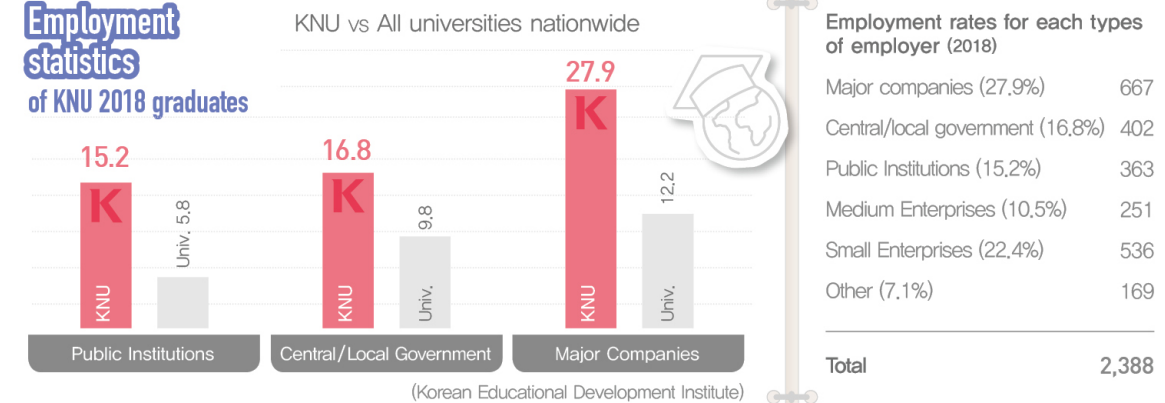

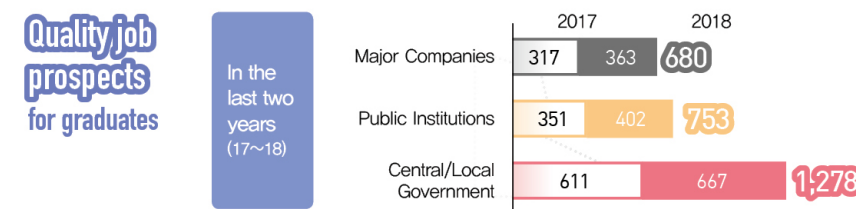
Employment statistics of KNU 2018 graduates



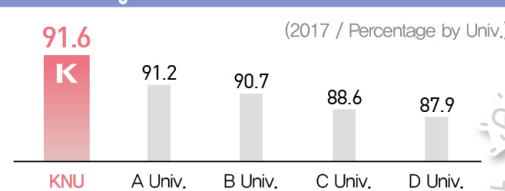
Expansion of employment opportunities for local leaders

 - The Local Quota System for local talent

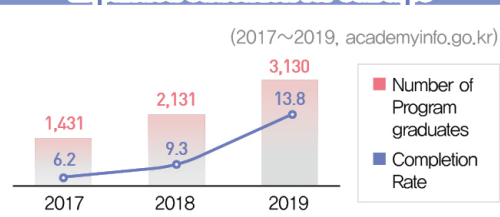
Quality job prospects for graduates



Highest retained employment rate among regional hub national universities



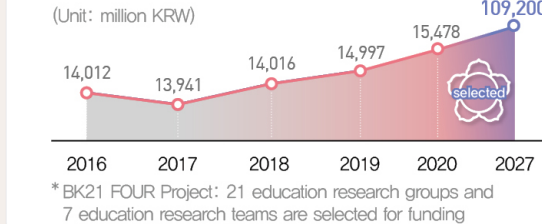

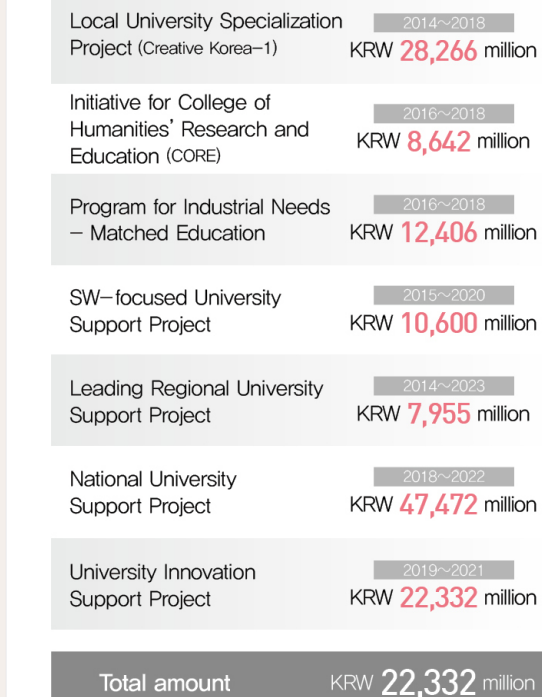

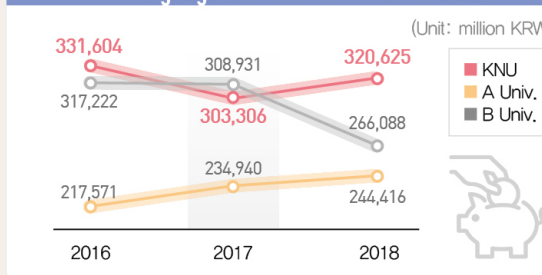
BK (Brain Korea) 21 Human Resources Development Projects



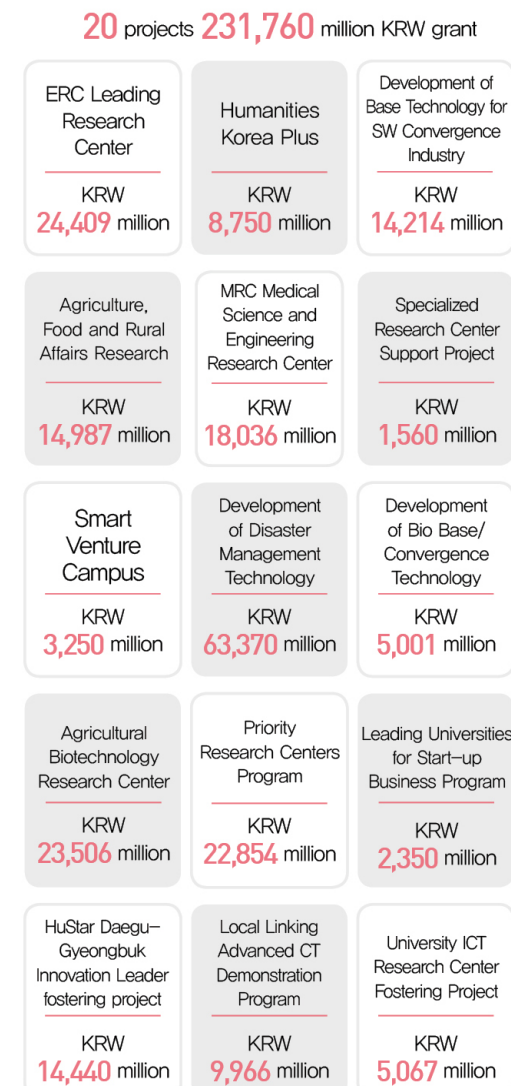
The highest level of Governmental Funding



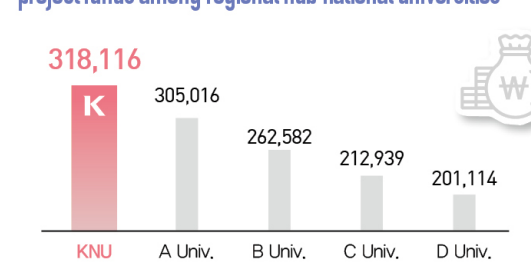

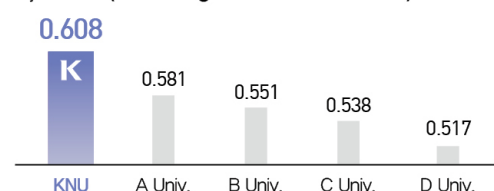

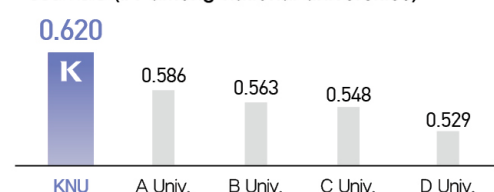

Researcher's individual publication rate

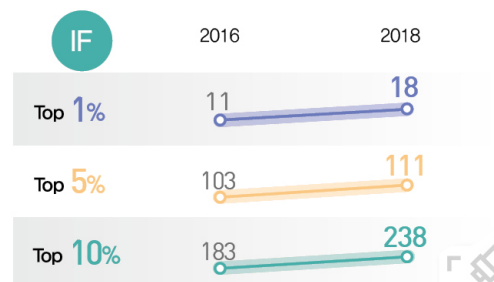
- The number of research papers in SCI-grade journals (#1 among national universities)
