


# Why KNU & Program Specifics




- Established in 1947, KNU is one of South Korea's 10 flagship national universities
- An EQAS university accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education (International Education Quality Assurance System)
- · One hour drive from the capital city of Seoul
- 18 colleges and 63 departments, 10 graduate schools and 55 research institutes
- 「Glocal University 30 Project」 winner (\$75.6 million funding from the government for 2024-2028)

- A transcript and certificate will be provided to each participant during the completion ceremony.

















